Our emphasis is on family living.

Each home provides 24/7 adult supervision by trained staff members.

Our children and youth, ages 6-17, go to public schools, play sports, participate in after-school activities, have chores and receive an allowance just like other kids their age.

We encourage accountability and responsibility to build confidence, self-esteem and leadership skills.

For our youth, JourneyZ represents the path to become a healthy, productive member of our community.

The children served through our JourneyZ program have endured some form of trauma, often repeated, throughout their lifetime.

Our trauma-informed staff and therapists work with our youth through:

- **Job readiness skills**
- **Individual and family counseling**
- **Educational enrichment**
- **Navigate community service skills**
- **One-on-one life skills development**
- **Personal development and growth options**
- **In home, licensed therapist visits minimum 2 times per week**
- **Access to psychiatric, nursing & community services**

- Gwinnett
- Fulton
