When young adults who have experienced homelessness finally move into their own home, it can be very overwhelming! Our Summit Trail Apartments provide apartments and critical support services for up to 70 people young adults and their children in a safe, secure environment. We want to provide our residents with a welcome home kit to help ease their transition into housing and provide them with basic items that address everyday needs so that they can focus on building positive futures.

We estimate the cost of each kit to be \$250. For your convenience, you can find many of these items at your local dollar store.
