Successful reentry into the community starts prior to release. During incarceration those involved have daily access to a CHRIS 180 counselor and/or reentry care coordinator to identify barriers to address in a plan to increase success returning to their community. Upon release, staff provide hands-on assistance to individuals returning to the community. Ongoing support and resource identification is provided.
