
CHRIS 180's Drop-In Center, The SPOT, is a trauma-informed safe space where emerging adults can plan and prepare for their future. As a weapon, drug, alcohol, violence, hate and shame free environment, we serve as a sanctuary for those experiencing homelessness and other vulnerabilities. Participants receive help with basic needs, a behavioral health assessment, life skills, resume and job-skill building, therapy and assistance securing housing.
